OUR TALE

Our students have already started our tale. German pupils started the story with Hansel & Gretel in Munich. Then the Polish students went on with it, and now the Spanish students are doing the going on.

Here there is a short summary of it:

Hänsel & Gretel are in Munich. It is Christmas time, after school they went to the Christmas Market. They strolled around the market with their mum, and finally they saw an old lady. They approached to her and she was a kind of a fortune teller. Hänsel wished to visit other countries and suddenly there was a strong thundering and lighting. the children got blinded with the light, and when they realized they were in an unknown place still a Christmas market but not the same. There they found a little boy like them. His name was Dratewska. Dratewska's talked to them and invited them to have dinner at his house.
